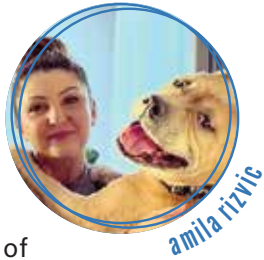


MONTHLY ROUNDUP

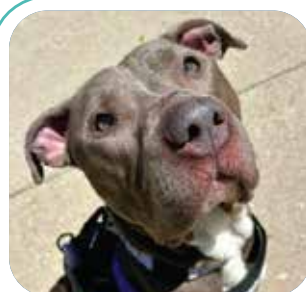
